



Sancho

Sancho is a Piel de sapo type melon with golden green skin and creamy white flesh. It produces very uniform large oval fruit from 6.5 to 9 lbs. in size and has shown to have excellent post-harvest shelf life. To obtain the best fruit quality, it is recommended to harvest fruit when the rind is more towards a golden color. Sancho is a good choice for growers wanting a larger Piel de sapo melon with tolerance to powdery mildew. Performs well in local markets and shipping.
